Restaurant: Drummer's Café located within the hotel seating up to 80 people indoors with additional outdoor seating for up to 30 on a scenic screened porch plus seasonal seating within the Atlantic Hotel's outdoor Courtyard.
The restaurant features casual Lite Fare dining from 11 am to closing and Fine Dining from 5 pm to closing. A full appetizer thru gourmet entrees and dessert menu is available 7 days a week.
The Atlantic Sunday Brunch/Lunch is served from 11 am to 3 pm. Outdoor seating is available seasonally.



Bar & Nightlife: The Drummer's Bar is open nightly with a full selection of specialty drinks as well as the traditional favorites, a wide selection of imported, domestic and craft beers, and an impressive wine list with all selections available by the glass.
